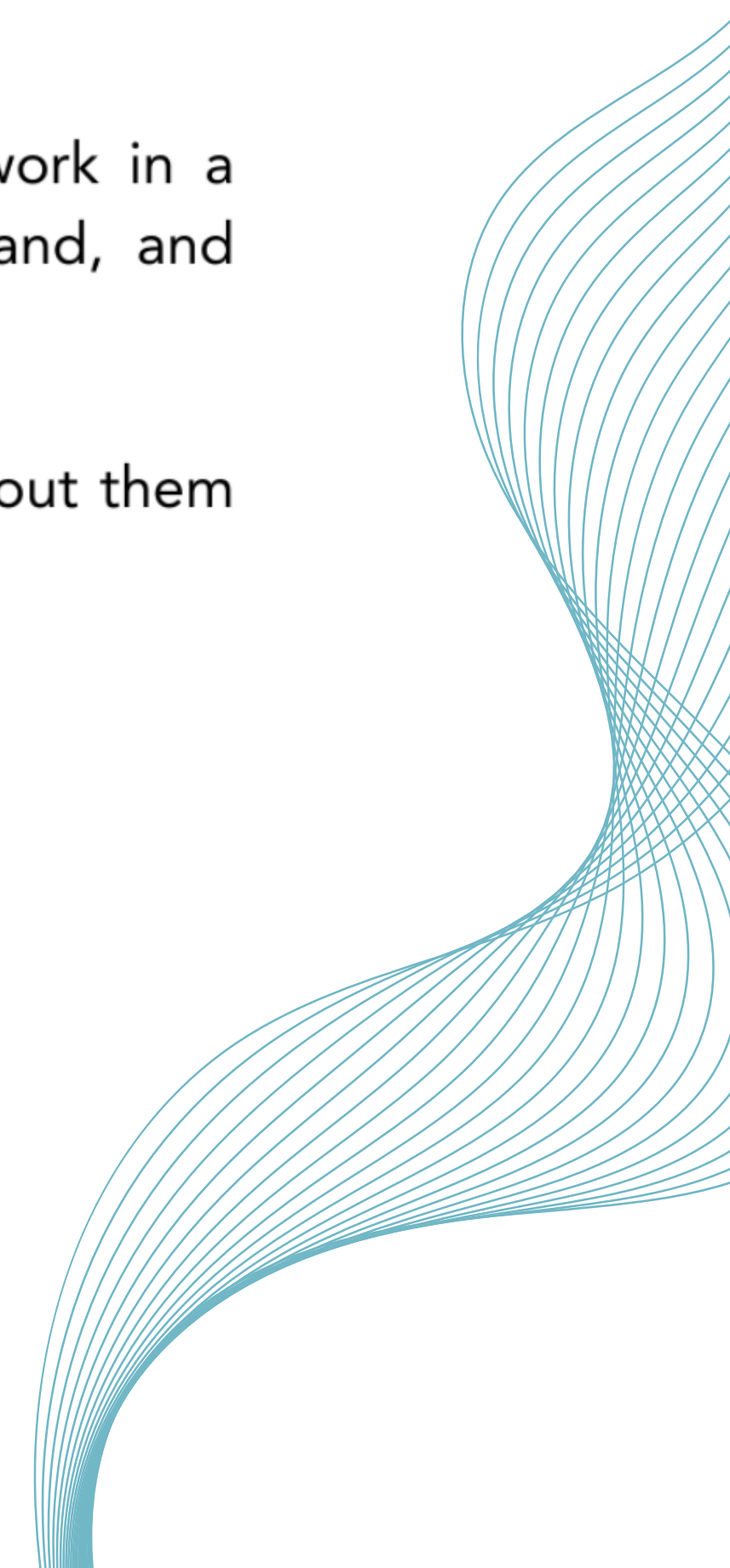

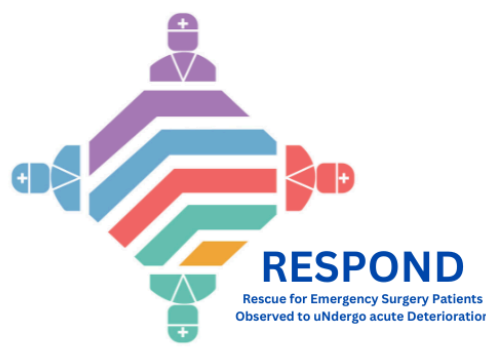
We encourage you to use this opportunity to showcase your work in a meeting that will involve invited guests from NIHR, NHS England, and organisations dedicated to improving patient safety.
